Curriculum

Mathematics

As part of our School Plan, the Visible Learning focus is Learning Goals and Assessment and Feedback. The students have all created a SMART learning goal for their Whole Number area of mathematics. English

Science

This term the Unit is about The Living World. The children will explore the concepts of living things, classification of living things, dichotomous keys, differences between animals and plants, habitats, life cycles and adaptations to habitats and species.

History

The unit this term will focus on Australian History- The establishment of the colony. It will explore the recorded facts about the first and second fleet, governing the colony, trade, Gold and the establishment of Government.

PDHPE

This term the theory component of PDHPE will focus on the area of Interpersonal Relationships. We will explore methods of communication, confidence, bullying, respect, friends, peer pressure and safe places. The physical aspect of PDHPE will involve all the fundamental movement skills, daily exercise and team games and dance on Fridays.

Creative Arts-music, dance, drama visual art

This year Creative Arts will be taught collectively every second Thursday and Friday by Mrs Underwood. This term the visual arts focus is on photography and landscapes. The music, dance and drama focus will be covered when the children travel to a country and explore their culture, music, dance, drama, art forms and famous artists.

Homework

Homework is kept in the blue bags. For Years 1-6 each child is required to read a reading card. It is expected that each child answers the 5 or 6 comprehension questions on the card. If your child can and is willing to answer more questions on the card they can. Each child is to write their spelling words in their spelling book each night. Kindergarten children are to read their alphabet reader book eg s, a, t, i, p, n, read their story reader and look at their alphabet flash book (blue exercise book). Ensure homework bags come into school each day.

Library

Library day is each Wednesday. Children will be able to borrow books each week. Please ensure library books are returned in the same state as they are borrowed.

Student Absence

If your child is absent from school you must ensure the office is notified by phone or email on the day of the absence before 9:00am. It is very important that we have a reason for the child absence. It is a requirement for all NSW Public Schools to document student absence and attendance.
