Geography

This term the children are completing a 'Location Investigation' each child has chosen an Australian town or city that they would like to investigate. The children have explored the different types of maps, components of maps and how to use an atlas. The children have explored the different seasons in each location. They have researched and found the maximum and minimum average temperatures for each month and the appropriate clothing to be worn in these locations. The chosen locations are: Tamworth, Albury, Magnetic Island, Brisbane, Melbourne, Darwin, Gympie, Bathurst, Sydney, Bribie Island, and Adelaide. Next week we will explore the natural, managed and constructed features in each location. The children will then explore the history and population of the location.
